

Town of Kirkland Organic Waste Program:

As part of its effort to reduce the need for landfill, reduce carbon emissions, and lower costs of waste removal, the Town of Kirkland attempts to assist residents with ecologically beneficial disposal of organic yard waste. The organic yard waste collected is turned in to wood chips for public use.

*** ORGANIC YARD WASTE DROP OFF ***

- The Town of Kirkland residents have the option to bring their yard waste to the Highway Department, located at 3699 State Route 12B during regular hours of operation:
Summer: 6:00 AM to 4:30 PM Monday thru Thursday
Winter: 6:30 AM to 3:30 PM Monday thru Friday

They may also do so on the following dates in 2020- Saturday July 11th, Saturday July 25th, Saturday August 8th, Saturday September 12th and Saturday September 26th from 8am to 11am

ORGANIC YARD WASTE PICK UP

The Highway Department, as a courtesy to residents, also picks up organic yard waste left on roadsides outside the Village of Clinton at least twice per year as deemed necessary by the Town Superintendent of Highways.

New language re: “Trash” definition and pickup:

Part II, Chapter 68: [Replacing definition of “TRASH”]

Article II: 68-11:

ORGANIC YARD WASTE- Leaves, tree limbs, brush, and similar yard waste (excluding grass clippings).

68-12:

B: Organic yard waste shall be collected at least twice per year as deemed necessary by the Town Superintendent of Highways
